Divisions Offered

Tiny Mite: 5,6 and 7 year olds as of 7/31/2025. Developmental/Non-Competitive. No weight limit.

9u: 7,8 and 9 year olds as of 7/31/2025. Developmental/Non-Competitive. Players over 110.4 #'s wear a number in the 90's and must play tackle to tackle.

10U: 8,9, and 10 year olds as of 7/31/2025. Competitive/Developmental. Players over 125.4 #'s wear a number in the 90's and must play tackle to tackle.

12U: 10,11, and 12 year olds as of 7/31/2025. Competitive/Developmental. Players over 140.4 #'s wear a number in the 90's and must play tackle to tackle

Reminder - we encourage players to register for the youngest age group in which they are eligible.

Regular Season Game Dates: 8/30, 9/6, 9/13, 9/20, 9/27, 10/4, 10/11 (Times TBD and will vary week to week. Generally 8 AM – 7 PM).

Regular season schedule generally published mid-week prior to the 1st game.

HCPW End of Season Tournament Dates: 10/18, 10/25 (Times TBD and will vary week to week. Generally 8 AM – 7 PM). All Teams Qualify.

I'd expect the 10/18 schedule to be available on 10/12 and the 10/25 schedule to be available on 10/19.



Post HCPW Season Play May be Available to Teams that Qualify at an Additional Cost for 9U and teams in the 10U and 12U Competitive Divisions.

It is likely that this year we will play oldest to youngest

There may be some play against teams outside of HCPW &/or Bye Weeks

Practice Expectations

1st 2-3 weeks of the season

Practice 4-5 days per week for 2- 2 1/2 hours

Once School Starts (Full week so week of 8/18)

Practice 2-3 times per week for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ Hours

Once Games Start

Practice 2-3 times per week for 1 ½ to 2 ½ hours

- Prior to the start of school some teams may choose to practice in the AM's
- Practices will be at LTISD facilities, Bee Creek County Park or LTYA FOD.



Practice Expectations

10 Hours of Conditioning in Helmets Only

All players in the presence of a team coach

10 Hours of Inter-Team Contact

Once these 20 Hours are complete, teams may scrimmage other teams in the same division.

*Note: Developmental Teams May Opt into or be Placed in the Competitive Division by HCPW post Jamboree evaluation & the Matrix team ranking.



Team Selection

Eligibility Based on the Players Age as of 7/31/2025

7th Graders – We encourage All 7 th Graders to Play Middle School Football

Players May NOT play middle school football and LTYA Tackle Football at the same time.

Balanced teams will be selected by snake draft starting with a total of 3 locked players

A / Competitive Teams are selected based on last years head coach input plus a pre-selection dialogue with LTYA leadership and age level coaches.

No Blanks on any Paperwork – Call the office if you have questions 512-261-1900

Report Cards Must be for the Full 24-25 School Year

No Doctor Signature Required on the Medical Form – Parent Signature is Fine

Tetanus Shot Must Have a Month and Year Minimum

If Not Vaccinated = N/A or Not Vaccinated

Addresses on all paperwork must match and be the same as what in on your LTYA registration account

No Nicknames on any paperwork – Names should match the Birth Certificate Name

Parents will need to supply the Team Parent Hard copies of all paperwork in addition to uploading into the registration system
